Miss Yael Gaelfer is a Consultant Paediatric Orthopaedic Surgeon with a special interest in clubfoot, DDH, skeletal dysplasia, and neurodisability. She is an Honorary Senior Lecturer at St George's University of London and a Teaching Programme Director to the Foundation Year 2 Doctors at South Thames Foundation School.

She is a BSCOS research committee member and a clubfoot consensus group member. Her research focus has been developing a core outcome set (COS) for research and treatment in clubfoot, various aspects of clubfoot management, the non-idiopathic foot, identifying risk factors for relapse, delivering a physiotherapy led Ponseti service, managing residual equinus in clubfoot, and developing a British consensus statement for primary treatment of clubfoot. Miss Gaelfer is leading a global collaboration for clubfoot research and training, as well as a European collaboration looking into long term outcomes of clubfoot treatment. She is involved in Global Clubfoot Initiative Ponseti courses and research into outcome validity in high and low/middle-income countries. She is a member of the BOA, BSCOS, EPOS and BSSCP.
