Professor Sandeep Patwardhan is a Professor of Paediatric Orthopaedics at the Sancheti Institute for Orthopaedics and Rehabilitation, Pune, India.

He obtained his MS Orthopaedics in 1995 under the guidance of Dr. N.S. Laud from Sion Hospital, Mumbai, which is one of the most reputed trauma centres in India. After settling in Pune, he joined Sancheti Institute of Orthopaedics and Rehabilitation, where he is currently Professor of Orthopaedics. He is registered with Maharashtra University of Health Sciences. He completed a fellowship in traumatology and joint replacement with Professor U. Holz in Stuttgart, Germany in 1999 and a fellowship in paediatric orthopaedics with Prof. E.H. Lee at the National University of Health, Singapore in 2000.

He has developed paediatric orthopaedics as a subspecialty in Pune, and he has led the Paediatric Orthopaedic Unit at Sancheti Institute since 2000.

He is also a visiting paediatric orthopaedic specialist at Jehangir Apollo Hospital and Bharati Vidyapeeth Medical College. He has given numerous talks on various aspects of paediatric orthopaedics at a state, national and international level.
